2013 TORRONTÉS

The emblematic white wine of Argentina, the 2013 Recuerdo Torrontés is cultivated in the Argentine province of La Rioja. The quality of this region results in extremely aromatic varieties. The wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks to preserve its fruit intensity and lively aromatics. A clear brilliant pale yellow color with intensely delicate fragrances of jasmine, citrus and a hint of honeysuckle and pears. Vibrant and harmonious in the mouth with zesty acidity and an elegantly crisp mouthfeel. A finish that provides a memorable impression of Argentina's native white wine.

Valle de Famatina, La Rioja, Argentina (3,298 feet altitude)

SOIL:

Deep sandy-clay soil of alluvial origin.

February 2013

VINIFICATION:

The grapes were sourced from 30-40 year old vines and were harvested at optimal maturity. Fermentation was slow, with selected yeasts, at low temperatures.
